



North Ayrshire Council - New Purple Bin Collected Every 3 Weeks As a North Ayrshire resident, you will have been notified of the new purple bin which was rolled out from April 2019 to allow North Ayrshire residents to recycle more at home. The introduction of this new bin will see a slight change in items that go into each bin as per the details on this leaflet:

RIGHT STUFF

Plastics - rinsed and squashed

- Plastic bottles
- Milk cartons
- Plastic tubs, trays and pots
- Fruit and vegetable punnets

- Cleaning product bottles
- ✓ Lids and tops
- Medicine bottles

Cartons - rinsed and squashed

Metals - empty and rinsed ✓

BLUE BIN I COLLECTED EVERY 3 WEEKS
