As part of the evening, charity events were held to raise money for the local North Ayrshire Foodbank and The Salvation Army, Saltcoats.

The Association were pleased to raise a total of $\pounds 5,259.50$ which was split between the 2 charities.

The Association presented a cheque for $\pounds 2,000$ along with toys to The Salvation Army (Saltcoats) Christmas Toy Appeal 2021 who work tirelessly to make a difference to families' lives in Ayrshire.

Making Our Communities Better Places Fund

The Board of Management were pleased to agree at their meeting of 13th May 2021 that they would reopen the Making Our Communities Better Places Fund for 2021/22 following the Scottish Governments decision to ease restrictions therefore allowing community projects/groups to function once again.

On Monday 9th August 2021 John Kelly, Chairperson of Cunninghame Housing Association presented a cheque for £1,000 to Brooke Neely, a young boxer from Ardrossan, as part of a 3-year sponsorship.

Brooke who boxes with Irvine Vineburgh Boxing Club, is also a member of the Scotland National Team. She is also the youngest member of the Boxing Scotland Elite Boxing Group. Brooke's training is split between Irvine Vineburgh and the Boxing Scotland High Performance Centre in Bridgeton, Glasgow. Prior to Covid-19 restrictions, Brooke was called up by her country to compete at the European Schools Championships in Tblisi, Georgia in 2019.

Brooke was selected to join elite athletes in Serbia for a 2-week training camp and also travelled to Birmingham for a boxing match with the English champion where she beat her on her home ground. Brooke's goal is to compete at the Commonwealth Games 2026 as well as the Olympics.

John Kelly, Chairperson of CHA commented, "We are delighted to be sponsoring Brooke who is a great ambassador for her sport."

The sponsorship money that Brooke has received from the Association has meant she has been able to purchase new equipment and assists with her travel expenses to Glasgow 4 times a week for her training as part of the Scotland Elite Boxing Group.

On Monday 4th October 2021 Janet Strang, Vice Chairperson of Cunninghame Housing Association presented a cheque for £1,000 to Craig Simpson, Football Coach of the Kilwinning Football Academy 2008's team.

The Kilwinning Football Academy 2008's team is a registered charity that provides football, nutrition and wellbeing to young children in North Ayrshire. The Academy currently has over 300 children registered and encourages them to eat healthy, exercise, develop positive relationships with others and to promote their confidence and skills.

Janet Strang, Vice Chairperson of CHA commented, "I was really pleased to present the cheque to Kilwinning Football Academy 2008's on behalf of Cunninghame Housing Association as Craig and his team do a great job with the boys and they recently received an award for 'Fair Play,' therefore, a big congratulations to them for that too."

The Mauchline Holy Fair Event is historically a community event, celebrating the heritage and history of Mauchline. Today, it is now one of the biggest events in East Ayrshire and engenders community spirit and pride in the village and surrounding area. The event consists of stalls, entertainers, funfairs and much more, with the help of many volunteers on the day itself. The event is arranged by a voluntary committee who in their own time apply for grants/donations and fundraise to ensure the community and anyone attending the Holy Fair enjoys the day.

John Kelly, Chairperson of Cunninghame Housing Association commented, "What a wonderful event to fund and support, looking forward to attending the event."



Allan Paton, Treasurer of the Mauchline Holy Fair commented, "The Mauchline Holy Fair Committee are extremely grateful for the funding received from Cunninghame Housing Association towards the costs of staging the Holy Fair Event. It enables us to continue with the century's old tradition of the Holy Fair, maintaining links to the past and engaging all age groups in moving the Holy Fair forward into the future. The generosity shown by Cunninghame Housing Association shows their genuine interest in being involved in the areas that they are working in and very much living up to their ethos of being "More than just a Landlord."

Academy Place, Lockerbie

In October 2021, a closing ceremony was held to mark the completion of 45 new homes on the former Lockerbie Academy site including 3 wheelchair adapted properties and 9 amenity flats. Prior to CHA's Lockerbie Academy development, no new social housing or housing for varying needs had been built in Lockerbie since the 1980's.



Total investment in the project was £8m. Works costs were £6.7m with £4.2m from the Scottish Governments Housing Association Grant (HAG). CHA contributed almost £3m in private finance and the project further benefited form £162,198 from Dumfries & Galloway Councils Town Centre Living Fund.



Through the main contractor, Ashleigh Construction, the project also created a number of employment opportunities including an Assistant Project Manager, Driver, 2 joiner trade apprenticeships and 2 modern apprentices. Sub-contractors were also able to start 3 apprentice electricians and 3 apprentice plumbers/heating engineers. 70% of the works were delivered by local supply chains which means that based on a \pounds 6.7m work cost, almost \pounds 4.5m stayed within the local economy.

Councillor Archie Dryburgh, for Annandale and East Eskdale, said, "It's really important to see these 45 houses come to fruition here in Lockerbie. Cunninghame came in about 4 or 5 years ago in Dumfries and Galloway and they've basically proved what they said they would do; they would be coming here to deliver, and they have delivered, mot only here in Lockerbie but in Gretna and Annan as well."

We're seeing the old secondary school site having been redeveloped with 45 new houses by Cunninghame Housing – great accommodation for people of all ages and backgrounds available to rent on what was an eyesore site."
